## **Moriah House Meals are a Huge Help!**

Fifteen parish members are part of a team that creates delicious meals for the transitional residents of Cleveland's Moriah House, part of the West Side Catholic Center. On the average 35 people are fed at a time.

On a monthly basis (and sometimes more) our team has created exciting theme menus like a Mexican Burrito supper or Italian night or comforting meatloaf and mashed potatoes. The meals all include fresh vegetables and are from each nutritional food group.

The team began working together in March of 2020, at the start of the pandemic, so they've not been able to serve the residents in the kitchen there and have fellowship time, *yet*.

However, team members do see each other when they gather in the parish parking lot before a meal is taken to the center. Take a look at our Facebook page for great parking lot pictures ;). Captained by Carol Krupka, the team has also prepared Holiday meals for the residents and even cooked a full Thanksgiving dinner, including homemade pies for dessert! And, on Christmas Eve the residents were treated to a full brunch and supper. They even donate extra fresh fruit and frozen veggies for when more is needed at other meal times.

We're one of a dozen churches that helps to prepare meals for the Moriah House, and the comments we hear are "the meals have been wonderful, always enough," and the "staff and residents are so grateful." Thank you to each and every one of the team, from those that give monetary help and those that lovingly prepare the food, to those that deliver it all to the staff and residents.
