..... **Cut It Out**.....

**"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy  
Spirit."**

The words are said as we draw a cross seeking God's  
blessing or initiating an experience of personal or communal  
prayer.

The descent of the right hand suggests the incarnational  
descent of the Second Person of the Trinity; the crossover  
from left shoulder to right suggests the movement of the  
Holy Trinity in our world.

The sign of the cross is there at the beginning of Mass. It  
introduces "grace" before meals. It initiates one's entrance  
into the sacrament of reconciliation. *It sets one apart  
momentarily from the distractions of daily life for the experience of  
quiet prayer.*
